
The Venue

Peterborough Arena is the one of the best exhibition and conference facilities in the UK. It has over 4600m2 of space available to accommodate up to 5000 people seated or 6000 standing, with the capability to cater for 1800 dinner guests.

It has state-of-the-art heating, ventilation and lighting systems, plus two VIP pods that can be used for corporate hospitality.
